****** New Process for CA Donation ******

We have heard back from many of our CA's (Contributing Artists') that the system of announcing that CA donations are due sometimes get lost in the shuffle. We really appreciate all the support and we want to make that process easier. Beginning next season, the treasurer will send individual pledges by email to current CA's for 2019 renewal. The pledge requests will come out on November 1st, 2018 and will be due January 1st, 2019. The pledge request will allow you to 'click to pay'. Artists' who wish to become a CA for the first time will still make the initial donation through the PayPal link on the website. That will get the artist into our CA database. Also effective in 2019 the minimal CA donation will be \$35.
