The exhibition will be judged, with prizes awarded in multiple categories.

TO PARTICIPATE:

- Art Association is responsible for arranging to have a juror select "Family Friendly" art to be submitted for this exhibition. Please contact Janeen Mason, Curator, at Lighthouse ArtCenter if jurying assistance is required (561) 746-3101.
- Art Association must provide a master list of members who are participating. Artists must complete an entry form and submit it online with payment and digital photo(s). US Mail or hand delivered applications with payment and photos are also acceptable.
- All artwork and sources must be original and attributable to the entering artist. **No** copies, gicleés or kits will be accepted.
- Work must have been completed within the last calendar year and may not have been previously shown at the ArtCenter.

FINISHED SIZE— Overall size not to exceed:

- Horizontal: 48" W x 36" H (Framed no larger than 53" W x 42" H)
- Vertical: 24" W x 72" H (Framed no larger than 29" W x 76" H)

PRICING— All work must be priced at the retail amount or marked Not For Sale (NFS), but you must provide the amount of value on the entry form.

NEW: SUBMISSIONS PER GROUP:

One piece of work per artist

- Art Associations with less than 15 members may enter a total of 5 pieces.
- Art Associations with 16—30 members may enter up to 10 pieces.
- Art Associations with 31—60 members may enter up to 15 pieces.
- Art Associations with over 61 members may enter up to 20 pieces.
- Accepted artists should complete the attached form and e-mail it with a digital JPEG image of artwork (no larger than 2 MB each).

ENTRY FEES: \$25 for each piece, one piece per artist. Entry form and fee must be submitted by **8/6/18**, along with .jpg image or photo of work(s) for potential use in advertising. Entry fees are nonrefundable.

IMPORTANT: When hundreds of images are sent via email it is very important to be able to identify them. When submitting your artwork by email please use the following naming convention in the subject line:

Lastname-Title-AOA18-Association
i.e.: Jones-Rose Garden-AOA18-BasketGuild

LABELS— Each piece of 2D art must be delivered with two labels securely attached, one on the back and one folded over the front (do not adhere labels to your frame front). The blank labels are available on the last page of the entry form—please copy as necessary.

DETAILS...DETAILS...

- **All 2D work must be securely wired for hanging. Saw tooth-style hangers are not acceptable.**
- All artwork, framing and structure must be strong and durable enough to be safely handled by ArtCenter staff during installation and de-installation.
- Unframed canvas works must be gallery wrapped and neatly finished on all sides (painted with no staples showing.)
- 3D work must not exceed 35 lbs. without permission of the curator. Check with Lighthouse ArtCenter to verify that we have pedestals available.
- Potters may submit up to four pieces per application, such as mugs or bowls or small sculptures. All four will be displayed in a grouping on single a pedestal, as available.
- Please sign your work but do not place large digital signatures or copyright logos on computer generated art.
- Good digital images, when provided early, are valuable in marketing and advertising. Please send images in .jpeg format not to exceed 2 MB.
- Artwork must remain on display for the entire exhibition. No exceptions. We must have your permission in writing to release your work to someone else at the end of the exhibition.
- Any artwork not in compliance with these rules will not be eligible to exhibit and no refunds will be given.
