- How does membership work in Plein Air Palm Beach Meetup group?

Email Notifications Policy

We have a large and active group and I want to make sure that our meetup members are notified of paint-outs we sponsor, and also area opportunities, but not unduly burdened with lots of email updates. Organizers can also send out announcements to the whole group or to subgroups, for example artists who

attended a particular meetup. Here is our policy for updates to meetup members.

As stated on the meetup site, our meetup mailing list is used only to notify members of our scheduled meetups, and notifications from group organizers.

Plein Air Palm Beach does not provide access to our mailing list to promote products or events.

However, I am happy to include contributing artist news & area plein air events in my NEWS updates for the meetup group. I generally send NEWS updates about every two weeks so those wishing to be in the NEWS Update should send me anything to be included in text format.

On the web calendar <http://www.pleinairpalmbeach.com/calendar.html> I have all the meetups as well as PAPB exhibits and community events. My criteria for a community listing is that it be in line with our mission and that it is a public event. The description section of a community event can have weblinks to your webpages, or pdfs. I only list PAPB events on the side bar of the menu page.
